

PROTOCOL for the Use of the International Judging System (IJS) owned by SEGL

1. Subject to date and hardware availability
2. User priorities: While conflicting competition dates are controlled to the extent possible by the USFS, conflicts remain possible due to the vast territory covered by the SEGL. The following guidelines will be used in an effort to prevent/resolve any potential conflicting usage needs of the SEGL IJS.
 - a. First Priority - SEGL Member Clubs with Share Ownership
 - b. Second Priority – SEGL Member Clubs without Share Ownership
 - c. Third Priority – Non-SEGL Member Clubs within the EGL Region
 - d. Fourth Priority – Non-SEGL Member Clubs outside the EGL Region
3. Reservations will not be accepted prior to one year in advance of competition start date, except for Qualifying Competitions which have been officially awarded
 - a. Please provide Qualifying Competition Award documentation with reservation
 - b. Qualifying Competitions in the EGL region take precedence over other regions

Please note: We are happy to rent the system outside the SEGL territory; however, we have decided NOT to commercially ship the equipment due to the increased wear and tear on the equipment caused by shipping. We will work with the User to arrange delivery via attending Officials, Coaches or other reliable party.
